

What does your walk say about YOU?



Most everybody walks, but not everyone does it the same way. A group of marching kids probably belong to a band, someone with a limp might be injured, and a friend quickly headed down the school hallway is likely late for class!

Observing someone's walk reveals a lot about them. In Ephesians 4:1-2, Paul talks about another kind of walk, the kind that shows the world that you are a child of God. "Therefore I ... implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called ... (NASB). This scripture passage describes the kind of walk that sets us apart as Christ followers. Paul doesn't just suggest, he implores you to consider the impact of your walk on people observing you.

Discuss: Why does Paul use the word "implore"? Why is your walk as a Christian important? What needs to change for your walk to truly reflect your relationship with Jesus?

Pray: Dear God, remind and equip me daily through your Holy Spirit to walk in a manner worthy of Your calling so that others see Jesus in me. Amen.
